The Post-Thanksgiving Wild Bunch Match

A great turnout! A few regulars were missing but we had 13 competitors with two being new shooters and our longest distance traveler winner Serenity from Canada. This marked the first competition featuring the new rule changes including now loading the magazine to 7 rounds. Lots of thought by the wild bunch committee went in to these rule changes and all of the changes apparently were made for current WB shooters to better the experience. With the changes it was decided that with the learning curve of seven round mags this day would feature 21 rounds from the pistol for a total of three magazines per stage in addition to shotgun and rifle. Penalties for the pistol were relaxed for this day only to further help shooters. An example of other changes included no declaration announcement of the model 12 and empty chamber slide forward movement penalty reduced from SDQ to a minor safety. Several other changes that are significant are now in the books. The stages all featured movement except for the last stage which was a stand and deliver 21 pistol rounds. All in all everyone adapted to the changes naturally and without a lot of hiccups. Rifle targets continue to be seen at 25 yards and further to the enjoyment of competitors. Our club president Shady McLarry shot with us and he is enthusiastic and motivated to the

wild bunch discipline. Shady said the club is flush with funds and he and the officers want to spend some money on improvements. He asked the club body specifically for ideas for props, targets, stages. If you have an idea Speak Up! This is opportunity knocking!

THE FIRST THANKSGIVING IN TEXAS

In the 1860s, 1870s and 1880s the Texas Panhandle progressively became famous in history for the Comanche raiding parties, the Comanchero traders from New Mexico, the Valley of Tears, and the Red River War against the Indians. These events were followed by the buffalo slaughter that nearly wiped out the bison. Next came the large cattle ranches that became famous along with the cattle drives to Kansas. All of this set the stage for the cattle rustlers and famous events that involved Billy the Kid and other outlaws. Wild cattle drive towns like Tascosa, shoot outs, Texas Rangers, and famous law men like Pat Garrett were the result. But before all of these events, the Panhandle was the location of the First Thanksgiving in the New World.

When we think about Westward Expansion and Manifest Destiny, consider that there are three reasons for exploration: Glory, Gold, and God. Expeditions set out in search of new places and people for the fame of being the ones to make these discoveries. They also undertake these endeavors in order to find wealth in the new areas. These journeys are often also about hope to find new people with whom to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ. More often than not, there's a little of all three in both the motivation, as well as the result.

In 1540-1541, the conquistadores of Francisco Vásquez de Coronado led a Spanish expedition which culminated at the Grand Canyon. This expedition set out to explore the New World

with Franciscan priest Juan Antonio de Padilla. Father Padilla accompanied their party as an official member of the governmental delegation to the expedition, in keeping with the traditional intertwining of state and religious affairs in so many Latin/Catholic Countries. Contemporary evidence suggests that Coronado, Padilla, and their men passed through the area of Blanco Canyon near present-day Lubbock, TX on their journey. Their expedition later endured the winter of 1540-1541 in the Rio Grande Valley at modern Tiguex, NM. Their mission was to offer Christianity and Catholicism to the Indians, collect as much wealth as possible from the New World, and waste little time in returning to Spain.

During this expedition, Padilla presided over the very first feast of Thanksgiving in the New World. This occurred as Coronado and the conquistadores camped in what is now known as the Palo Duro Canyon of Texas in 1542. When some of the conquistadores chose to depart later that same year, Father Padilla and some of his entourage chose to remain in the New World. Three black men, a Portuguesa soldier named Andres do Campo, and several Indian converts from his monastery at Zapotlan also elected to remain with Padilla. The family members of one of those black men also chose to stay behind with him.

As a result, Father Padilla would earn the distinction of becoming the very first Christian martyr in Texas, as well as the New World. He lost his life at the hands of some angry tribesmen while attempting to spread the Gospel to these indigenous people on 30 November 1544.

In a letter sent home to Spain, Coronado provides the first description of the Llano Escnacado, the Staked Plains of the modern Texas

Panhandle. Though he traveled more than 300 leagues across the Plains, he didn't see the end of them. He didn't find any rocks or trees either. This would be the same area where the Red River Indian Wars would take place 333 years later. This would also be the region where the buffalo hunts would happen that finally drove the Indians on to the reservations in the Indian Territory at that time.
