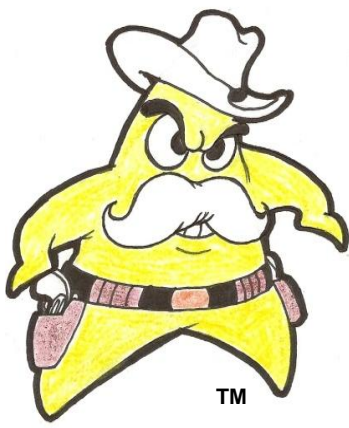

This is Open to ANYONE who has never shot a SASS Type, Cowboy Action Match before!  
We especially encourage Ladies and Youngsters to participate!

We will cover the history of Cowboy Action Shooting, the clothing, firearms, ammunition, rules, safety, what to expect at a match and how a match is run. Then you will shoot an actual cowboy scenario. We will provide all firearms and ammunition. You are encouraged to bring your own firearms and ammunition, however all equipment must be reviewed for safety prior to use. Safety glasses and ear protection, is mandatory for this activity and ASC will provide this if you do not have your own. This is a Cowboy Action event, so attendees are invited to wear Cowboy Hats and Cowboy Boots. It is also suggested that for personal safety, that you wear long pants, a long sleeve shirt and covered shoes (no sandals).

**This clinic is not meant to be initial firearms training.** It is designed for those who are already familiar with firearms operation. It is scheduled to last approximately 4 hours and will begin promptly at 10am in the Schaefer Pavilion at the Arlington Sportsmans' Club. All attendees will receive a confirmation via E-mail. There is a \$10 per person attendance fee, which will cover the cost of ammunition. A free lunch will be provided.

The sport of Cowboy Action Shooting consists of shooting targets, many of which are steel, with live, all lead, ammunition. Participation in this sport is done so *with the knowledge that shooting firearms is inherently dangerous and it is impossible to guarantee, completely, that occasional lead splatter will not enter the shooting and spectator area.* Every precaution is taken by the Arlington Sportsmans' Club to make this a safe activity; however we cannot be responsible for injuries or property damage caused during shooting matches. The club is not responsible for personal injuries, damage to vehicles, equipment, firearms or clothing. **Unsafe behavior, improper use of firearms, failure to obey safety instructions, use of alcohol or drugs (illegal or performance hampering prescription), or failure to respond to any safety command will result in an immediate call of cease fire until the situation is rectified.**
