## **A SHORT STORY OF THE 30-30**

The story of the 30-30 begins with its parent cartridge, the Ballard 38-55. The 38-55 was a true 38 cal bullet (actually varies between .375" to .379" dia), backed by 55 grains of Black Powder. Ballard introduced the cartridge for their single shot rifles, but Winchester later adopted the Ballard 38-55 cartridge for their rifles.

When Winchester wanted a new cartridge, they took the 38-55, necked it down to a 30 cal and filled it with 30 grains of smokeless powder, BUT retained the popular designation of that time. All of the cartridge dimensions are the same with the exception of the bullet diameter, and the 30-30 cartridge will chamber into a 38-55 rifle. There is enough space in the 30-30 cartridge to hold 55 grains of Black Powder, however commercial loadings for the cartridge only contained the new smokeless.

The 30-30 was first introduced in 1895, and to my knowledge has the distinction of being the very first commercial rifle cartridge on the american market, that used only smokeless powder. The 30-40 Krag has the distinction of being the first US military cartridge to use smokeless, in 1892. A lot of other cartridges started with Black Powder and made the transition to smokeless, but the 30-30 was smokeless from the beginning.

The biggest boon to the 30-30 however is when Winchester rechambered their Model 1894 lever action rifle, which had been initially introduced in 38-55, into the new cartridge. The performance of the new cartridge was recognized by other gun makers, like Marlin, who immediately introduced rifles in the caliber, but the 30-30 Model 94 combination became an icon to this present day. And the rest, as the say, is history.
