Be sure and set aside the weekend of October 28th and 29th for our annual match (Showdown) with a Halloween theme.

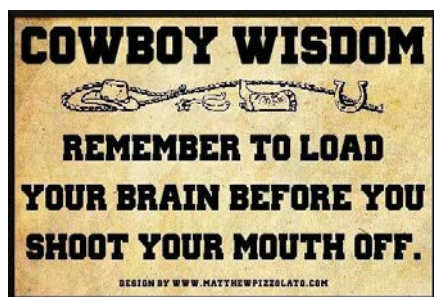
## FROM THE LSFSC PRESIDENT

## ROCK CONTINUED

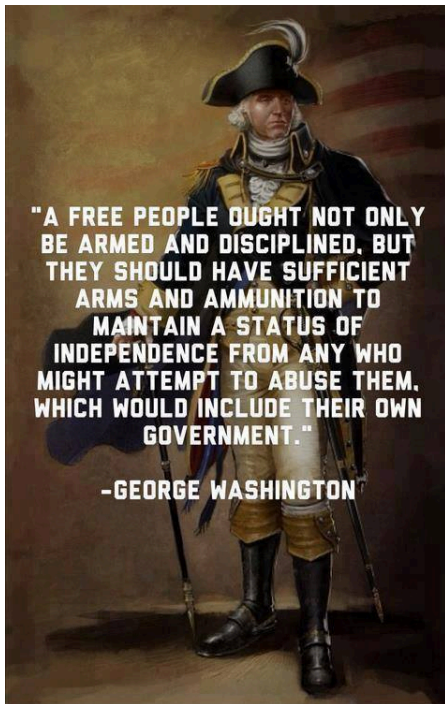

This last month was a different Wild Bunch match, featuring mostly 20 round pistol with a couple at 15 always 10 rifle and 5 to 6 shotgun. All targets were very hittable with various sweeps and movement thru out the stages. This WB match was held beginning at the bank and leap frogging the cowboy shooters all the way to the fort thru various stages.

Before the match began it was noticed that Wicked Felina's pistol had lost a grip screw and it was Goatneck Clem to the rescue by sacrificing a screw from his spare pistola. It's always good to have a top tier gunsmith handy. Speaking of guns, Choctaw Al was shooting a stage and had his 97 kinda lockup, worked thru it and it ran well the rest of the day. Dead Eye Bob looked to be enjoying the stages using all his guns with authority, he is accurate! Our match director and

Shady McLarry also shot with the group while navigating us thru the different scenarios.

It turns out he is a good WB shooter in addition to cas. Shady wanted to intertwine the Cowboys and Wild Bunch shooters but not hinder either group by trying to shoot the same stages. Targets were kicked out to WB distance on the stages we shot and the first few stages had a cowboy feel from long ago. This was not a technical match, no dueling trees or hostages were harmed this day, however Chula Kat was stuck on scoring duties do to a fight with a steel shotgun target that didn't like where she put her hand!

This was a great and fun group to shoot with and after 4 stages a poll was taken to do a quick burn it down pistol stage 15 targets from 3 locations at the fort. This stage went really fast. Watching Evil Roy shoot this stage was the definition of fast and smooth. Silver Sam put up his .22 and hauled out his 45 along with a sharp looking lever-gun and had a great day. Finishing the WB match attention was turned to BAMB. We were missing a few shooters to family commitments but introduced a different element into the game by using a Colt hammerless 380 at the beep retrieve this pistol and fire three rounds on steel go to the end of the stage and Nevada sweep three targets go to the other end and sweep the other three. Second BAMB was a double tap on five targets. Captain Sam Evans did a great job on the second stage and was really fast and smooth. On this same stage Capt. Bruce Jarrett was using his k31 and his shot to shot was extremely fast but a faulty stripper clip caused a round to dislodge and had to be fed in by hand costing some time, still the speed was very impressive!

June 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>, about a half a dozen Wild Bunch competitors from

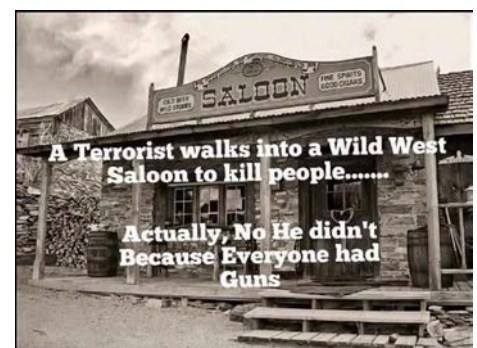
our club will head to the great state of Oklahoma for the Oklahoma red dirt wild bunch state championship

# A HORRIBLE INDIAN MASSACRE

During the 1850-60s in Texas, some of the worst Indian massacres ever recorded occurred in what was then the frontier of Northwest Texas. The area comprises the region from just outside Weatherford, TX to the area up just north of Ft. Richardson (Jacksboro), and south around present day Mineral Wells, Palo Pinto County. The Comanche and Kiowa and others would leave their reservation in the Indian Territory of present day Oklahoma, and on horseback would raid the scattered and isolated farming and ranching families.

In 1860, the Ezra and Martha Sherman family lived on their little homestead in the Cross Timbers on the eastern edge of Staggs Prairie (north and a little east of present day Mineral Wells, TX). The father, mother, and three young children were about a mile from their nearest neighbor. One afternoon, several Comanche approached the house. As was always the case in such situations, the family was way out numbered; about all they could do was welcome the Indians to offer them food, which they did. Suddenly, the Indians overpowered the small family.

They told the father to take the two children and leave (one child had hidden); the Indians kept Mrs. Sherman there to do with her whatever they pleased. Mr. Sherman did not want to leave; the savages told him they would kill all four of them if they stayed, so he took the two children and headed east toward the nearest neighbor on Rock Creek, a mile away. About a half mile away, he heard the horrible screams of his

wife. Mr. Sherman decided that he must go back. He could not stand the horrible terrifying screams, as the Indians were surely torturing her. So he sent the children on toward the neighbor's farm yet a half a mile away, as he went back to try to help his wife. The children begged him not to leave them, for he would possibly be killed too. But he went back.

What he found was overwhelming. Martha had long black hair. After seventeen Indians raped her, they tried to scalp her. The act of scalping consisted of using the knife to cut along the hair line, above the forehead, and around to just above the ears. This was just enough to grab hold of the scalp to rip and tear the scalp off, often taking much of the skin on the back of the neck as well. This allowed the Indians to maximize the torture and pain, as they shot arrows into the person. The victim was usually left to suffer and die an awful painful death. This procedure was what they tried to do with Martha Sherman.

Mr. Ezra Sherman found his wife scalped, but still alive; she had several arrows shot into her. It took her four days to succumb to her injuries, which included the exposed bone of her skull. She was able to relate to her husband what happened. She said the Indians could not get her scalp to come off, so they tied her hair to the tail of a horse. As one Indian sat on her and another Indian rode the horse, they dragged her around the yard till her hair and scalp finally tore away and came off. Then they shot her with several arrows and left. Such tortures were common, and resulted in the pioneers developing a true hatred for all Indians.

This event was part of a far reaching raid of historical importance and sweeping consequences. Such raids, murders, and tortures became

common all over the area, resulting in settlers' often retreating back to Weatherford for protection. As the raids became worse, the outcry for the government to do something eventually resulted in the Red River Indian War of 1874. Supposedly, this led to the Indians being put back on the reservations and made it safe for the continued settlement of the regions of Northwest Texas and elsewhere on the Texas frontier.

The raid mentioned in this story occurred on what is now the Baker Family Historic Farm, which has been in the Baker family since 1897 (120 years).

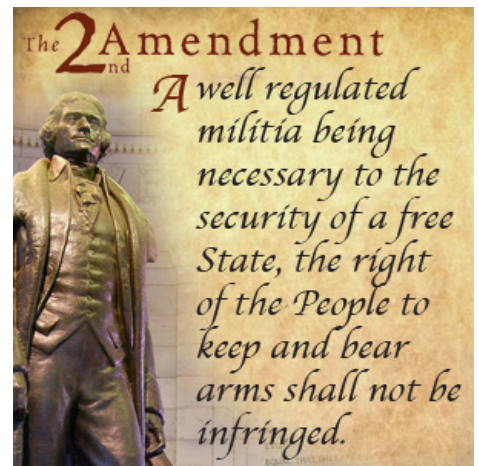
